

ST. SCHOLASTICAL MUSIC MINISTRY OPTIONS

(October 15, 2018)

Note: Needs to complete the diocesan/sate Safe Environment requirements

Cantor:

- Able to sing as a soloist
- Good vocal ability
- Leads the Assembly in song from the microphone
- Audition required
- Schedule with Sr. Pat as able to commit
- Individual rehearsals with Sr. Pat or, if a choir member, at choir rehearsal

St. Scholastica Choir:

- Leads the Assembly as part of the choir
- Generally decent vocal ability, although no audition is required
- While ability to read music is helpful, it is not required
- Able to commit to Wednesday evening rehearsals from 7-9 pm
- Able to sing on Sunday mornings for the 9:30 am liturgy *(Note: Off in the Summer)*
- Able to come for Sunday morning warm-up in the Pastoral Center at 8:50 am
- If unable to commit to the entire season *(Sep-early June)*, able to sing for a part of the choir season *(Fall, Advent/Christmas Season, Winter, Lent/Holy Week, Easter Season)*

Instrumentalist:

- Good instrumental ability
- Audition required
- Schedule as able to commit
- Optional individual rehearsals, if needed, or during choir rehearsal

Resurrection Choir:

- Willing to be a compassionate vocal presence at parish funerals
- Are a visible extension of our parish outreach to bereaved families
- Generally available to sing for morning funerals *(Generally at 10 am)*
- Able to come for warm-up at least 30 minutes before the funeral time
- No audition required
