

Religious Education Options:

Grades k-5

For students in grades K through 5 three options are provided. The student may attend class at St. Scholastica on Sunday morning from 10:00am - 11:15 am, Tuesday evening from 6:15pm to 7:30pm or via home study (with monthly check in with religious education staff). Second grade students will also engage in sacramental preparation. This will include a Reconciliation Retreat.

For students in grades 6 thru 8 two options are provided:

The student may sign up for small group catechesis or home study. As with the younger students home study will require a monthly check in with the religious education staff. The small group catechesis schedule varies year to year. Students may select a particular group on Catechetical Sunday. Group leaders are considered catechists and are trained as such.

Family Ministry

Monthly there will be "Family Ministry" offerings at our sister parishes of Juan Diego and Padre Pio. These are considered part of the religious education requirements and attendance will be taken. The schedule of parish locations and Sunday times will be posted.

Confirmation

8th grade students, in addition to their 8th grade catechesis will be required to engage in sacramental preparation for confirmation. This is accomplished through monthly MEGA meetings at St Scholastica. There will be a parent meeting in September to explain the sacramental preparation process.

Summer Homestudy

For some families summer home study is the best option. If you are interested please contact the Director of Religious Education.
